

Connecting Stitchy units to the Philips Hue Hub

1. The below process assumes that all your lighting and Stitchy units have been electrically connected and the power is on.
2. Ensure all units or at least 1 unit is in 'search' mode by either turning the light switch in the opposite direction 5 times or pushing the 'Reset/programming' button on the front of the unit 5 times
3. The next step is only if the App is not open. If the App is open and already ready to "Add lights" go to step 3. Open the Hue App, click "Home", click the 3 dots in the top right-hand corner and click "Light setup"
4. Click "Add light" and then click "Search"
5. Once the search has been conducted a full list of all the lights available should now be shown. If you do not have all the lights, you can search again or go back to step 1 and repeat at a later point
6. Click on each light to identify which room or area they are in. When you click on the light you will notice that it flashes for easy identification. Once you know which room they are in click on the "i" to rename it to a something more suitable. REMEMBER: This will be the identification when you use voice control so keep names simple. For example: "Josh's light" is much better than "Default back corner bedroom light"
7. Click "Next"
8. Test control by clicking "Home" and turning lights on/off
